I. Church Is a Team Sport

- a. 5 things team leaders are doing:
 - i. Connecting people to the team
 - ii. Contributing to the mission of the church
 - iii. Equipping team members for ministry
 - iv. Shepherding team members
 - v. Blessing team members for their sacrifice

II. Planning a Team Meeting

- a. Purpose, People, Place, Process
- b. Great meetings include:
 - i. connecting relationally, understanding our contribution, being equipped to do it, being shepherded along the way, being blessing and appreciated
- c. How to plan for collaboration
 - i. Set some parameters, but leave some open.
 - ii. (vote, voice, vehicle)
- d. Communicating with the team ahead of time



III. Leading a Team Meeting

 - i. Not being afraid of contrary ideas or healthy conflict
- b. Bringing closure and next steps
